I shall collect the bound copies on the 27th September and then distribute them. We will provide a copy to the Church, County Archive Office, National Library of Wales and a personal copy for Caroline Speyer in appreciation of the work of Paul Speyer who was our founding member. The digital copies for the Church Care Library, the Royal Commission on Ancient and Historical Monuments of Wales and the Victoria and Albert Art Library will be distributed by the team at the Arts Society.

We hope to present the copy for St Elidyr Church to the incumbent, Reverend Caroline Mansell, at a service later in the autumn to which members will be invited.
