Notes.

Coventry Cathedral is one of Britain's most remarkable post War buildings. Designed by Basil Spence and featuring major works by Graham Sutherland and John Piper, the Guided Tour (cost £8.00 including the cathedral entrance fee) lasts approximately 1 hour and includes the history of the Ruins, the Blitz and the building of the New Cathedral.

Compton Verney is a 'stately home' which was saved from decay to become Warwickshire's award-winning art gallery which is home to six diverse collections of nationally and internationally significant art from Britain and around the world. It is set in 120 acres of Grade II listed park, landscaped by Capability Brown, which remains much as Brown designed it with lake and Cedars of Lebanon.
(Admission to house and grounds and all Exhibitions £15.00 per person - £14.00 for over 60s)

The RSC Shakespeare Memorial Theatre offers a full 'behind-the-scenes' tour lasting approximately 1 hour covering both Front of House and the secrets of back-stage and under stage. (cost £8.50 per person with a reduction for Groups [TBA]).

Upton House (NT) houses a selection of works from the vast collection of Lord and Lady Bearsted. He founded the Shell Oil Company and he and Lady Bearsted spent their fortune on a vast collection, only part of which can be displayed at Upton House. On display, however, are works by George Stubbs, Hogarth, Bosch, El Greco and Gainsborough. The surrounding gardens feature the astounding Ha Ha – a surprise for discovery! (Entry is, of course, free to NT members but £11.45 for non-members, reduced to £10.00 for groups of 10+)
